The **China Systems Nanjing Development Centre** has completed tests on the compatibility of their AS400 Eximbills trade finance system with OS400 Version 6.1 (V6R1), and certifies that no errors have been found.

It is **China Systems** policy to subject its software and subsequent releases thereof to predefined tests that give expected results to determine compatibility with supported operating systems and corresponding upgrades.

The compatibility test was performed on AS400 Eximbills, covering the following areas: SWIFT, Customer Liability, Interest Accrual, and Core Program functionalities such as Central Control, Security, Standing Data, Trade Finance, Utility, and Communication.



OS400 Version 6.1 (V6R1)

OS400, also commonly known as IBM i or i5/OS, is IBM's operating system for its AS400 line of business computers.

Because OS400 is closely attuned to the AS400 hardware design and generally comes as part of the basic package, there is no alternative operating system to compete with it.

OS400 is built to operate with the AS400 logical partition (LPAR) architecture, in which multiple instances of the operating system can run concurrently in different partitions. Among other uses, LPAR is useful when migrating to a new release. The old production system can keep operating in one partition while a new system is being tested.

OS400 Version 6.1 was released in January 2008.
